Description of the event and its activities:

The event brought together representatives of all six EU project partners, along with educators, civil society actors, and experts in civic engagement, for a full day of exchange and collaboration focused on democracy, civic participation, and youth empowerment.

The meeting officially opened with participants' registration, followed by a welcoming speech delivered by Mr. Mihnea Ionuț Badea, President of Nameless Art Association. He highlighted the importance of transnational cooperation in strengthening democratic values and underlined the role of civil society organizations in fostering active participation among young people and communities across Europe.

Session I, facilitated by the NOTSKIP coordinators Mr. Evangelista Leuzzi (Italy) and Ms. Iulia Gabriela Badea (Romania), set the framework for the day. The session provided an overview of the NOTSKIP project and its Training Curriculum, while also presenting a progress report on project implementation. Partners reflected on achievements so far and discussed the current stage of development, ensuring a shared understanding of objectives and next steps.

In Session II, the focus shifted to the broader European context of civic participation. Mrs. Oana Balutescu, CERV National Coordinator, presented the CERV Programme and its crucial role in supporting citizens' engagement and democratic participation at EU level. This was complemented by the intervention of Ms. Alexandra Cernica, who shared her personal volunteering experience, illustrating the concrete impact of volunteering on civic awareness and active citizenship.

Following a networking coffee break, Session III explored the role of education in democratic inclusion. Mr. Ciprian Nistor, teacher at the "Tudor Vianu" National High School of Computer Science and member of the NOTSKIP network, addressed schools as drivers for democratic inclusion, emphasizing the importance of early civic education. The session continued with presentations and roundtable reports on local awareness-raising campaigns, followed by a dedicated feedback session facilitated by LGD Poland, allowing partners to exchange perspectives and good practices.

The afternoon concluded with Session IV, an internal working session for NOTSKIP partners. Participants took part in a podcast training led by influencer Ms. Inas Ali, exploring digital tools as innovative means to communicate civic values and engage wider audiences. The session continued
